## **Activities**

- 3. ToT course of 20h in English in Rome for 12 trainers: 2 notaries and 2 judges for each country, selected by the call.
- 4. Two seminars and exchange of best practices in Italy, of 1 ½ days for 24 legal practitioners.
- 5. Two seminars and exchange of best practices in Hungary, of 1 ½ days, for 24 legal practitioners.
- 6. Two seminars and exchange of best practices in Bulgaria, of 1 ½ days, for 24 legal practitioners.
- 7. E-learning game in English of 2h for 12 legal practitioners in three countries.
- 8. E-learning course of 20h as self-learning tool to be uploaded on a MOOC.
- 9. Two sit-coms in English.
- 10. One Handbook on specific legal terms in English and examples of C.L.I.L. methodology to be published online.
- 11. External Evaluation.



## Subjects identified

- a) <u>Family law</u> (Family relationships: spouse, civil partner, cohabitee. Ownership regime: joint tenancy and tenancy in common. Separation and divorce. Spouse and child maintenance. Parental responsibility. Judicial remedies and enforcement procedures).
- b) <u>Succession</u> (Succession by will and intestate. Validity, alteration, revocation of a will. Statutory rights of spouses/civil partners (forced heirship). Personal representative nominated in the will. Distribution of the estate to heirs/beneficiaries. Judicial remedies and enforcement procedures. The European Certificate of Succession).
